BACKSTAGE VOLUNTEERS

We will be needing 2 backstage volunteers for each class—some classes may require 3, depending on size of class. Backstage Volunteers will need to attend all rehearsals from beginning to end, and remain backstage with the children during the show from beginning to end. Backstage Volunteers play an important role in making the recital come together! If you are interested, please sign up at the front desk. All volunteers receive a free keepsake yearbook and waived registration fee for Fall Season 2024-2025.

Please have your child ready in their class costume on the day/time of class. Make sure all costumes are labeled to avoid confusion and loss! Also, bring class dance wear to change into afterwards for normal class.

*Please set a reminder to bring costumes! We've seen too many times where a student is left out due to not bringing costume to class.

**If costumes were ordered/paid late (after December), there may be a chance that your costume will not be delivered in time for class photos.

- Please arrive on time for your photo window.

PARENT/STUDENT ID'S & BACKSTAGE PASS

- Parent/Student ID's & Backstage Volunteer ID's will be required for ALL Tech Rehearsals, Dress Rehearsals and Recital for checking your student in & out.
- No one will be allowed backstage without an ID or Backstage Pass.
- ID's will be handed out once June tuition + <u>ALL</u> balances are fully paid for the season.

RECITAL CHECK-IN & CHECK-OUT

Policies & Procedures

All of the following procedures are subject to change

Bravo's Recital Check-In & Check-Out Policies & Procedures are designed to make sure that all children are safe and accounted for while off the Bravo premises. We thank you for understanding and hope that you can agree that safety comes first!

*Check-In and Check-out Procedures will be followed at all Technical Rehearsals, Dress Rehearsal and at Recital.

REQUIREMENTS FOR CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT:

- Parent/Student ID and/or Backstage Volunteer Pass
 *These will be handed out once June tuition + <u>ALL</u> balances are fully paid
- Parent/Guardian present for drop-off & pick-up if under 16years old/non-driver.

PARENT/STUDENT ID BADGE:

Parent/Guardians will be required to have their Parent/Student ID badge when checking in & checking out their child. Students will not be allowed backstage at the Moran Theater without this! All balances must be up-to-date and paid off before these will be handed out.

Payments WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED at Jacksonville Center for the Performing Arts-NO EXCEPTIONS!

BACKSTAGE VOLUNTEERS PASS:

All Backstage Volunteers will also need their backstage pass to get backstage. These will also be handed out once all balances are paid up-to-date - **NO EXCEPTIONS**!

BACKSTAGE ACCESS AT JACKSONVILLE CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS, MORAN THEATER:

Backstage access at the Moran Theater is limited!

<u>During Show</u> - Closed. There will be no access to backstage areas during the show. There will NOT be Bravo Faculty available at the Check-In/Check-Out Table. Children cannot be checked out during the show.

<u>Intermission</u> - Limited Parent Access with Parent ID. Pre-Combo Students Check-out Only. Please contact Hailey Smith or Kyle Wynn, Owners/Directors, for special circumstances.

End of Show - Limited Parent Access with Parent ID. One parent only allowed for pick-up backstage.

TECHNICAL REHEARSALS

MONDAY, JUNE 3rd, TUESDAY JUNE 4th, THURSDAY JUNE 6th @Bravo School of Dance

This year's Technical Rehearsals will be held at Bravo School of Dance. All dances in the recital will be scheduled to run each piece on certain days, separating Act I and Act II. Even though you will be dropping your child off at the studio, our Recital Check-in & Check-out Policies and Procedures will still need to be followed. Therefore, no curbside drop-off or pick-up will be allowed.

#1 Monday June 3rd 6-8:00pm - All dances in ACT I only

#2 Tuesday June 4th 6-8:00pm- All dances in ACT II only

#3 Thursday June 6th 5:30-8:30pm - ALL DANCES - ACT I & ACT II

ACT I dances 5:30-7:00pm | ACT II dances 7:00-8:30pm

*A copy of the dance order for Act I and Act II will be available soon.

PROCEDURES FOR CHECK-IN @ TECHNICAL REHEARSALS:

- Bring child to Check-In/Check-Out Table, Parent/Student ID required!
 Parents/Family members are not allowed to stay due to limited space, unless signed up as Backstage Volunteer.
- Please wear regular dance attire & appropriate shoes.
- DO NOT BRING COSTUMES TO TECHNICAL REHEARSALS!

PROCEDURES FOR CHECK-OUT @ TECHNICAL REHEARSALS:

 Parent/Student ID's will be required to check-out students at Check-In/Check-Out Table. Parent/Guardian will need to be present at pick-up. Curbside pick-up will not be allowed.

TECHNICAL REHEARSAL

As mentioned, a schedule of dances will be set in place and sent out as soon as available. Due to the limited space at the studio, drop-off & pick-up times will need to be strictly followed. They will be set in place to minimize the number of students inside. Please make sure that your child is promptly dropped off and promptly picked up.

*As per Bravo Policy, late pick ups will receive a late pick up fee!

PRE-COMBO STUDENTS AGES 2-4YR ONLY — # 2 Tuesday 6/4 at 6:00pm

Technical Rehearsals for our 2-4yr pre-combo classes will be on Tech Rehearsal #2 Tuesday 6/4 at 6:00pm until they have finished. Plan for at least 30 minutes. This is the only Tech Rehearsal for this age group. Only 1 parent may stay, due to limited space.

DRESS REHEARSAL

DRESS REHEARSAL – Saturday, June 15th @ Jacksonville Center for the Performing Arts, Moran Theater, 300 West Water Street, 32202

- Act 1 Dancers should arrive at 8:00am-All performers arrive with costumes & in FULL hair & makeup exactly as it will be worn in the recital. Dressing Rooms will be assigned by class. Please label all items to avoid loss & confusion.
- Act 2 Dancers should arrive at 11:30 a.m.- All performers arrive with costumes & in FULL hair & makeup exactly as it will be worn in the recital. Dressing Rooms will be assigned by class. Please label all items to avoid loss & confusion.
- Only one Parent will be allowed to drop off child backstage. Parents cannot stay backstage for rehearsals, except for PC Parents and Backstage Volunteers.
 Parents may watch dress rehearsal in the audience.
- Backstage Volunteers must stay for the entire rehearsal, with the exception of Pre-Combo Volunteers.
- Pre-Combo Students—see next page for separate guidelines.
- All performers will rehearse until 1:30-2:00pm, or until finished. <u>Please be aware that dress rehearsals may go over in time.</u>

WHERE TO CHECK-IN

All students must enter the theater through the main entrance from Water Street. After entering the lobby, turn left down the front corridor and you will see the Check-In Table and backstage entrance. You will show your parent/ guardian authorization badge to the Bravo representative at the check-in table. After dress rehearsal, you may pick up your child from the same area where you dropped them off. If rehearsal runs over in time, parents may sit in auditorium until done.

RECITAL TICKETS

Get ready to witness an unforgettable performance at our upcoming dance recital! Secure your spot by purchasing your tickets through <u>ticketmaster.com</u>. Prices will vary depending on your seating preference: Orchestra Level seats offer assigned seating starting at \$25, while General Admission tickets are available for \$15 with no assigned seating, but be sure to arrive early as it's first-come, first-served. Remember, seat-saving is NOT allowed! For those looking to save on additional Ticketmaster fees, we encourage you to swing by the box office at Vystar Veterans Memorial Arena from Monday to Friday between 10AM and 4PM. Stay tuned for notifications when tickets go live on <u>ticketmaster.com</u> - it's your cue to secure your front-row seats to an evening of enchanting performances!

RECITAL NIGHT

- <u>Pre-Combo & Act 1 Performers</u> must arrive backstage at 5:00pm in full makeup & hair with labeled costume. Pre-Combo and performers in <u>Act 1 only</u> must be checked-out at intermission to watch the rest of the show from the audience.
- Act 2 Performers should plan to watch in the audience until intermission. Costumes are NOT to be worn in the audience! When intermission starts, Act 2 performers should be escorted to the check-in table. Performers should be ready in full hair and makeup.
- Drop-off procedures same as Dress Rehearsal—Parent ID required @ Check-in table
- Theater doors open at 5:30pm for those with a ticket. Orchestra Level Seating is assigned seating labeled on your purchased ticket. General Admission Seating is on a first come bases. Seats cannot be saved.
- Access to Backstage will be limited and closed off until Intermission.
- For students remaining backstage after the finale, parents are to pick up their child backstage AFTER the show. Parent ID badges will be required. Only 1 parent please.

*Keepsake Yearbooks and Recital T-Shirts will not be sold at the theater. Pre-order yours today - \$25. Playbills will be provided at no cost (no ads or photos, just dances).

Our dance recital is recorded by a professional videographer, ensuring that every moment is captured with precision and clarity. The video will be made available to everyone as part of their recital fee, allowing them to relive the magic of their performance.

TECHNICAL REHEARSAL:

DRESS REHEARSAL:

- Arrive no later than 8:30am and report to the Loading Dock in full hair/makeup/costume
- Only one parent will be allowed backstage with their dancer (Parent ID required)
- PC classes will be one of the first to rehearse their dance onstage, then will be dismissed immediately until call time 5:30pm that evening.

RECITAL:

- PC students will perform in ACT 1 only and will need to be brought backstage at 5:30pm.
- Only ONE parent will be allowed backstage with their dancer, then return to the theater for the show.
- PC STUDENTS ONLY can be picked up at INTERMISSION and can sit in the audience for the remainder of the show (must wear cover-up over costume in audience—See Jacksonville Center for the Performing Arts below)

GENERAL INFORMATION JACKSONVILLE CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS RULES:

The following will give you some general information regarding the policies and procedures for the Jacksonville Center of the Performing Arts. Please inform parents of these policies in advance of your recital.

- Outside food and drinks are strictly prohibited in the theaters at all times. Concessions and bars will be open during recital.
- Performers may not go into the theater at any time in costume. Violation of this policy will result in an additional cleaning fee (sequins & feathers) assessed to Bravo.
- Tickets are required for entry to Jacksonville Center for the Performing Arts.
- Bravo's recital is assigned seating (labled on ticket, seats selected at purchase) and general admission tickets is first-come first-served, seats may NOT be saved.
- Streamers, helium-filled balloons, glitter and confetti are strictly prohibited at Jacksonville Center for the Performing Arts.
- Strollers are not allowed inside the theater.
- Firearms of any sorts are strictly prohibited. Even with a concealed carrying license.
